How Unique Can you be? Use your imagination and be artful in creating Snow Art in Encampment during Winter Carnival.

Tips & Tools

- Use your imagination—especially if there is a lack of snow.
- Spatulas, ice cream scoops, buckets, boxes, whatever tools you need to pack to build your snow art are acceptable.
- Dress in lots of layers and stay warm!

Contest Rules

- All entries must be located within the Encampment town limits. If the area of your snow art is not on your property, please have permission to do your snow art in that area.
- Your creation should be large enough so that it can be seen from the street.
- If you paint, YOU MUST USE NON-TOXIC PAINTS! Spray bottles with water and a few drops of food color make the snow very colorful.
- To enter, fill out a registration form at the Encampment Town Hall or The Red Wagon by noon on Friday January 25th. You have 24 hours to complete your work. Snow Art will be judged on Saturday January 26th beginning at noon.
- If you are under 18 years of age your parent must sign your registration.
- All Snow Art must be family friendly!
- Contestant information and photos may be used by the Town of Encampment and the Platte Valley Arts Council for announcing winners and for on-going promotional purposes.

Prizes will be awarded in cash! Winners will be announced Saturday January 26th during the Cook-Off Contests at the Grand Encampment Opera House.
