The office of municipal judge is created and said justice shall be appointed by the mayor with the consent of the council and shall be a qualified elector and resident of the town. He shall give bond in an amount determined by the town council conditioned upon the performance of his duties and that he will turn over to the town treasurer all moneys collected by him by virtue of his office as municipal judge. Said officer shall have jurisdiction to fine, enter judgment, sentence, imprison, and hear and determine all cases arising under the ordinances of the town. An alternate judge may be appointed at the discretion of the mayor and council and need not be a resident of the town. (Prior code § 1-508)
